

- Over six to eight months, students cover key theoretical subjects such as flight principles, air law, meteorology, aerodynamics, navigation, power plants, flight planning, and aircraft systems.
- A Class 1 Medical Certificate is a prerequisite, ensuring candidates meet the required health standards. Training begins with single-engine aircraft, focusing on fundamental flight operations, including takeoff, landing, airport procedures, and radio communication.
- To succeed, candidates must demonstrate discipline, situational awareness, stamina, adherence to schedules, and emotional resilience, all of which are essential for earning a Private Pilot License.
